



# AIR FRANCE DROPS 'PLAN B' RESTRUCTURING

**Air France is reported to have dropped its "plan B" restructuring of job losses that triggered clashes with staff last year.**

In new plans outlined to the airline's works council, Air France targeted growth in its long-haul network from 2017, Reuters news agency reported.

The measures are conditional on greater productivity efforts from pilots and cabin crew.

Net investments would exceed EUR€1 billion by 2020.

The airline said last week it would post a 2015 operating profit for the first time since 2008.
