



AIR FRANCE SAYS PARIS ATTACKS COST 70M EUROS IN DECEMBER

Franco-Dutch airline group Air France-KLM said Monday that the November 13 terror attacks in Paris reduced its December turnover by an estimated 70 million euros (\$76.42 million, Dh280.5 million).

But the effect had largely tailed off over the past two weeks, it added.

“The negative impact of the Paris attacks on December revenues is estimated to be around 70 million euros, with significant easing during the last two weeks. Booking trends in December were in line with a progressive recovery,” the group said in a press release.

Total traffic in December for Air France, KLM and low-cost subsidiaries HOP! and Transavia, was 6.7 million passengers, “stable” over the previous month.

Seat occupancy was 82.9 per cent, a fall of 0.2 per cent, it said
