Latvian airline *airBaltic* has become a member of Baltic Institute of Corporate Governance (BICG).

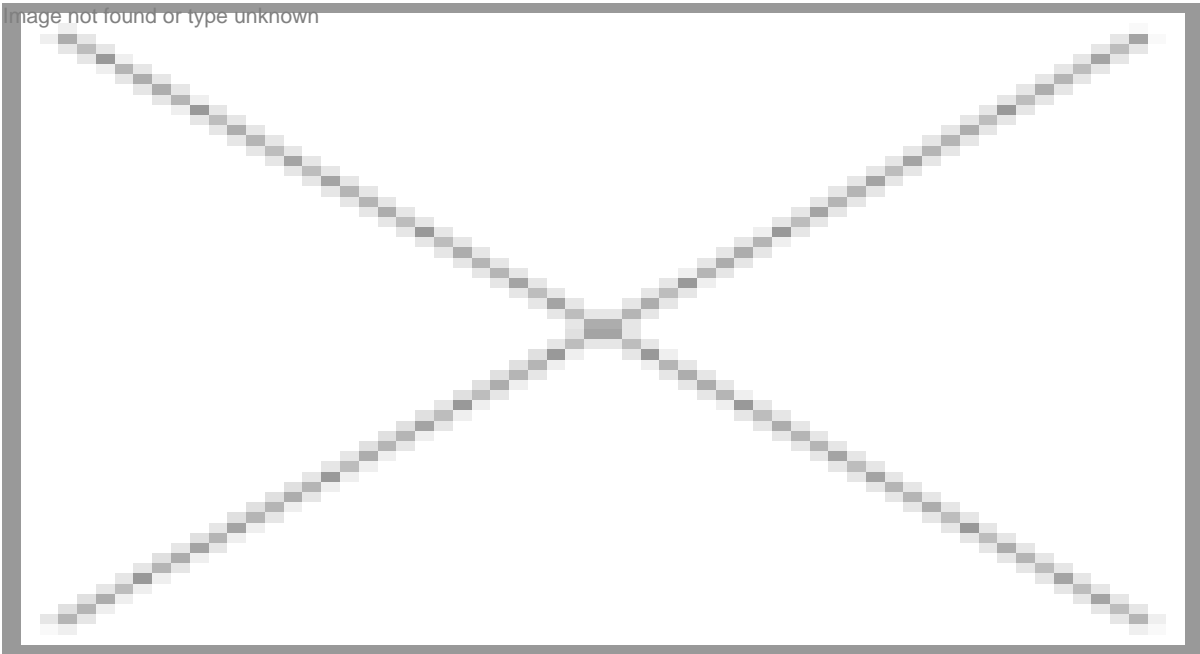
