



CAE AND GLOBAL CROSSING AIRLINES SIGN EXCLUSIVE A320 PILOT TRAINING AGREEMENT

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CAE has signed a long-term exclusive pilot training agreement with Global Crossing Airlines to deploy and operate an Airbus A320 family full-flight simulator in Miami, Florida. The FFS is scheduled to be ready for training in the first quarter of 2024 to support GlobalX's ongoing growth and the expansion of its Airbus A321 freighter fleet.
