



EUROWINGS GROWS IN THE CAPITAL REGION 42 ATTRACTIVE DESTINATIONS IN THE 2025 SUMMER FLIGHT SCHEDULE

Eurowings is significantly expanding its range of attractive direct destinations from BER: In the 2025 summer flight schedule, travellers can choose from 42 attractive destinations via Germany's largest holiday airline. The Lufthansa subsidiary, in particular, is expanding connections to popular holiday regions in southern Europe: For the first time, Eurowings will be flying from BER to Bilbao, Corfu, Faro and Jerez de la Frontera. Newcastle in England's north-east is a further addition to the programme.

The airline is also increasing its frequencies to existing destinations: Malaga, Heraklion, Rhodes, Graz, Helsinki, Nice, Kos, Split, Yerevan and Erbil will be served more frequently in the future. Mallorca remains the top destination in the BER programme: Eurowings will be offering up to 21 flights a week from BER to Germany's most popular holiday island.

Aletta von Massenbach, CEO of Flughafen Berlin Brandenburg commented: "We are very pleased about Eurowings' commitment to BER. The airline will offer travellers from the capital region a wide range of new and attractive travel options in Europe and beyond in the coming summer flight

schedule. At the same time, the expanded offer will improve the region's accessibility for international guests and, therefore, strengthen BER as an airport location, tourism and the regional economy."

Jens Bischof, CEO Eurowings said: "Berlin and Eurowings are a good match: we are delighted that we can not only continue our growth story at BER, but even accelerate it. Following the very successful expansion of our connections to the Gulf region, we will also be strengthening our presence in the capital in the summer of 2025 and, at more than 200 weekly flights, will be offering our most wide-ranging European programme to date. Our commitment is a clear commitment to Berlin as an aviation location, with which we are expanding the Lufthansa Group's market leadership in the capital."
