



NORWEGIAN APPOINTS JAN DE RIJK AS RFS

Norwegian Cargo has appointed **Jan de Rijk** Logistics as its road feeder service partner to extend its delivery network to more than 50 airports across Europe.

The carrier says freight Forwarders will be able to take advantage of its expanding network between London and the US. It says shipments arriving in London from the US will be able to

make onward connections to other European Airports such as Brussels, Amsterdam and Frankfurt within 48 hours of departure.

Norwegian says customers can benefit from 15 tonnes of bellyhold capacity in its Boeing 787-8 Dreamliners serving six long-haul destinations from London.
