



RHENUS MOVES HISTORIC RALLY CARS FOR HONG KONG – BEIJING RALLY

Rhenus Logistics has moved two historic Audi 80 Quattro rally cars from the UK to **Hong Kong** for the Hong Kong – **Beijing Rally** 2015.

The cars were moved from Bebington (UK), to Heathrow Airport before travelling to Hong Kong via Luxembourg in a journey that took 10 days. They were then delivered to the owner of classic car and rallying company, S&P 4X4, Victor Ma. The vehicles were chosen because the same model won the inaugural Hong Kong – Beijing Rally in 1985.
