



TAIWAN'S UNI AIR ADDS MAIDEN A321; OUTLINES NETWORK

[Uni Air](#) (B7, [Taipei Sung Shan](#)) has outlined its proposed [A321-200 \(sl\)](#) operational plans following the arrival of its maiden aircraft of the type - B-16209 (cn 6042) - last week.

The former [EVA Air](#) (BR, [Taipei Taoyuan](#)) twinjet has already been deployed on flights from its [Taipei Taoyuan](#) hub to [Xi'an Xianyang](#), [Harbin](#), and [Shenyang](#) in China. Effective September 20, Airline Route reports the aircraft will be deployed on flights to [Zhengzhou](#), [Dalian](#), [Macau Int'l](#), [Ningbo](#), [Chongqing](#), [Guilin](#), [Qingdao](#), and [Hohhot](#).

Uni Air is a turboprop-heavy airline operating thirteen ATR72-600s and five [MD-90](#)s. A321-200s will replace its MD-90-30 fleet in due course.
