Starting from April 2, 2019, Azerbaijan Airlines (AZAL) will launch regular flights on the route Baku -Almaty-Baku.

AZAL flights will be operated twice a week on Tuesdays and Saturdays by Airbus A319 Aircrafts with Economy Class, Comfort-Club and Business Class configurations.

Departures will be carried out in Terminal 1 of Heydar Aliyev International Airport.

Almaty is called the "southern capital" of Kazakhstan. The city is in the foothills of Trans-Ili Alatau - incredibly beautiful snow-capped mountains, a kind of visiting card of the southern capital.
