



BLUE AIR LINKS IASI TO FOUR EUROPEAN CAPITALS

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Blue Air commenced services from [Iasi](#) (IAS) on 25 October to four European capitals including a domestic link to the Romanian capital, **Bucharest** (OTP). Services to **London Luton** (LTN), **Paris Beauvais** (BVA) and [Rome Fiumicino](#) (FCO) were also launched. All four routes will be operated by the carrier's 737-400s and 737-500s according to OAG Schedules Analyser, with only services to Paris Beauvais not facing direct competition. Apart from services to Bucharest which will operate 12 times a week, the rest will operate either twice or thrice-weekly. Blue Air plans to further expand its operations from Iasi with the introduction of routes to Barcelona, Brussels and Cologne Bonn next summer.
