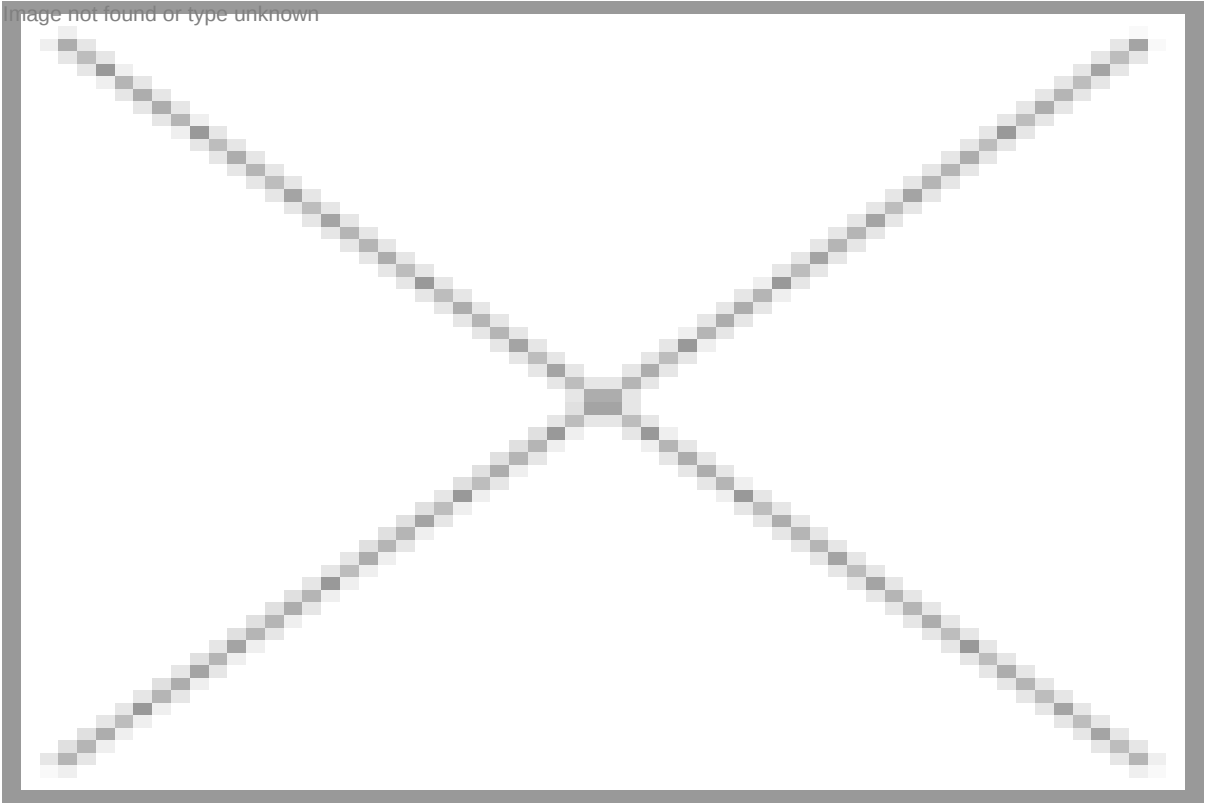


Set foot into Chanel's latest pop-up store here, and you'd swear you were at a real airport.

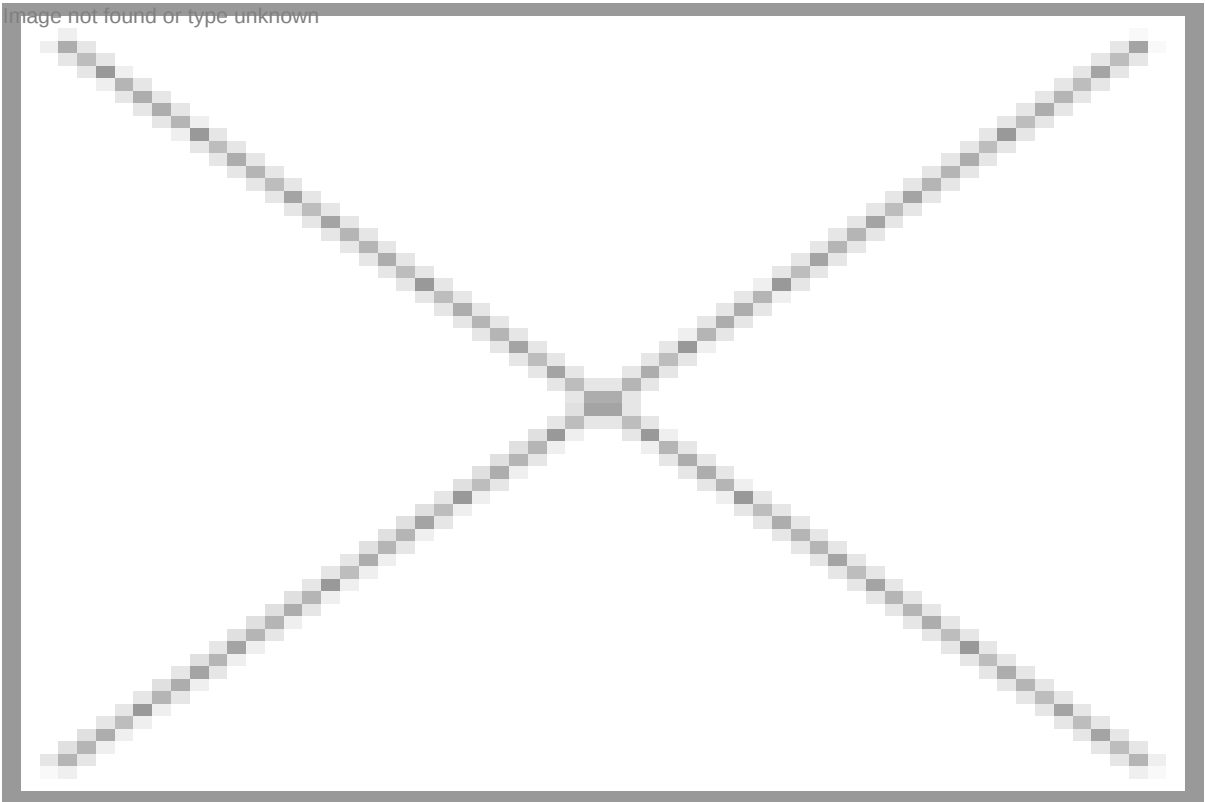

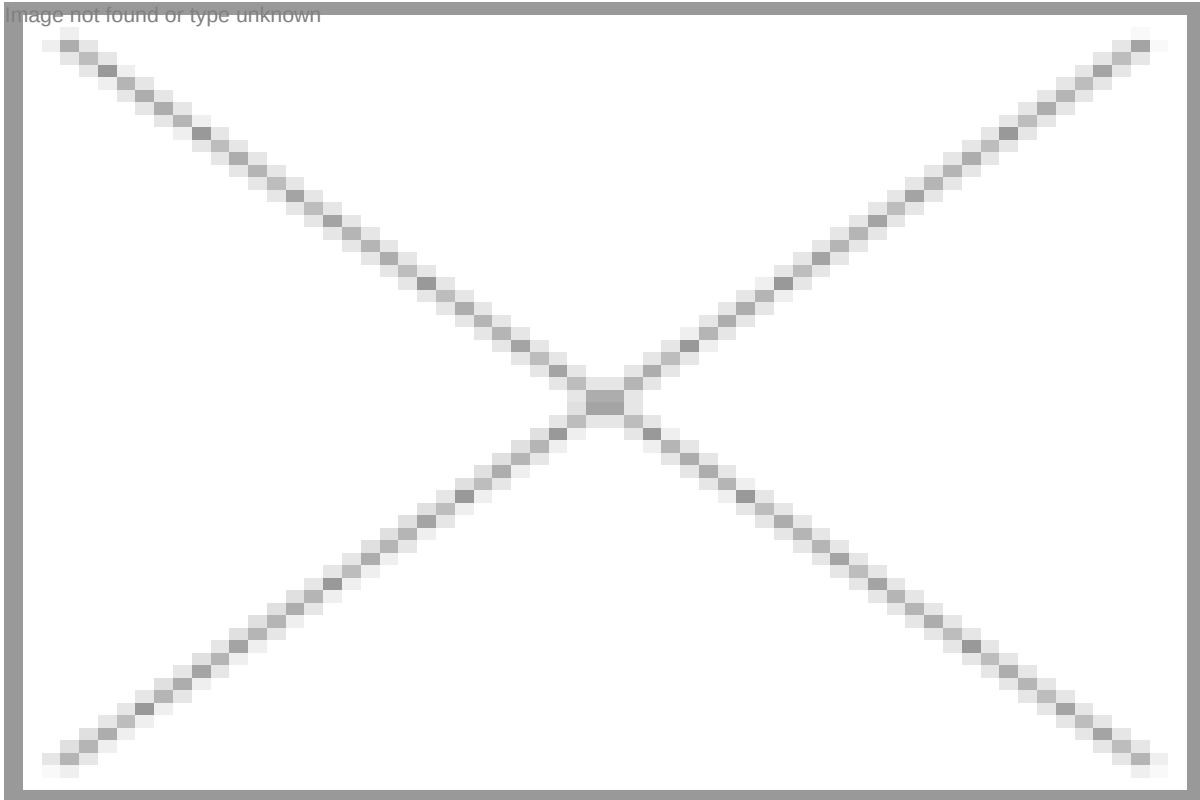
Beauty aficionados are not left out of Chanel's travel plans either, with a beauty counter installed in the space, offering a selection of the brand's signature beauty products.
