



EMAAR JOINS HANDS WITH BEIJING NEW AEROPOLIS HOLDINGS TO DEVELOP THE AERO-ECONOMIC AREA OF BEIJING DAXING INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

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At a ceremony held at the China National International Convention Centre, Dubai-based global developer Emaar today signed a memorandum of understanding with Beijing New Aeropolis Holdings (BNA) to jointly develop a Business and Tourism Complex, integrating retail, entertainment, office, hotel hospitality, convention, sport, art and lifestyle functions in a one-stop solution within the Aero-Economic Area of Beijing Daxing International Airport, set to be the largest airport in the world.
