



LONDON BIGGIN HILL EXTENDED OPENING HOURS WELCOMED BY BUSINESS AVIATION COMMUNITY

London Biggin Hill Airport, the only dedicated business aviation airport within the capital, is reporting a significant increase in movements at the airport following the introduction of extended opening hours on May 1.

The latest 'Business Aviation INSIGHT' report from WingX Advance shows that since the new operating hours came into effect, the airport has seen an 21% increase in business aviation movements year on year.

The new extended hours of 06.30 to 23.00 Monday to Friday and 08.00 to 22.00 at Weekends and Public Holidays has been especially welcomed by North American and Middle East based customers in particular.

operating hours has been the right decision for our airport and shows our commitment to offering our customers unrivalled flexibility and service.
