The Airbräu Wiesn starts on Saturday, September 17 at 11:30 a.m. with an ecumenical blessing of the home-brewed festival beer "Gaudium". Passengers and visitors can further enjoy exclusive Oktoberfest offers and discounts in the airport stores until October 10.
