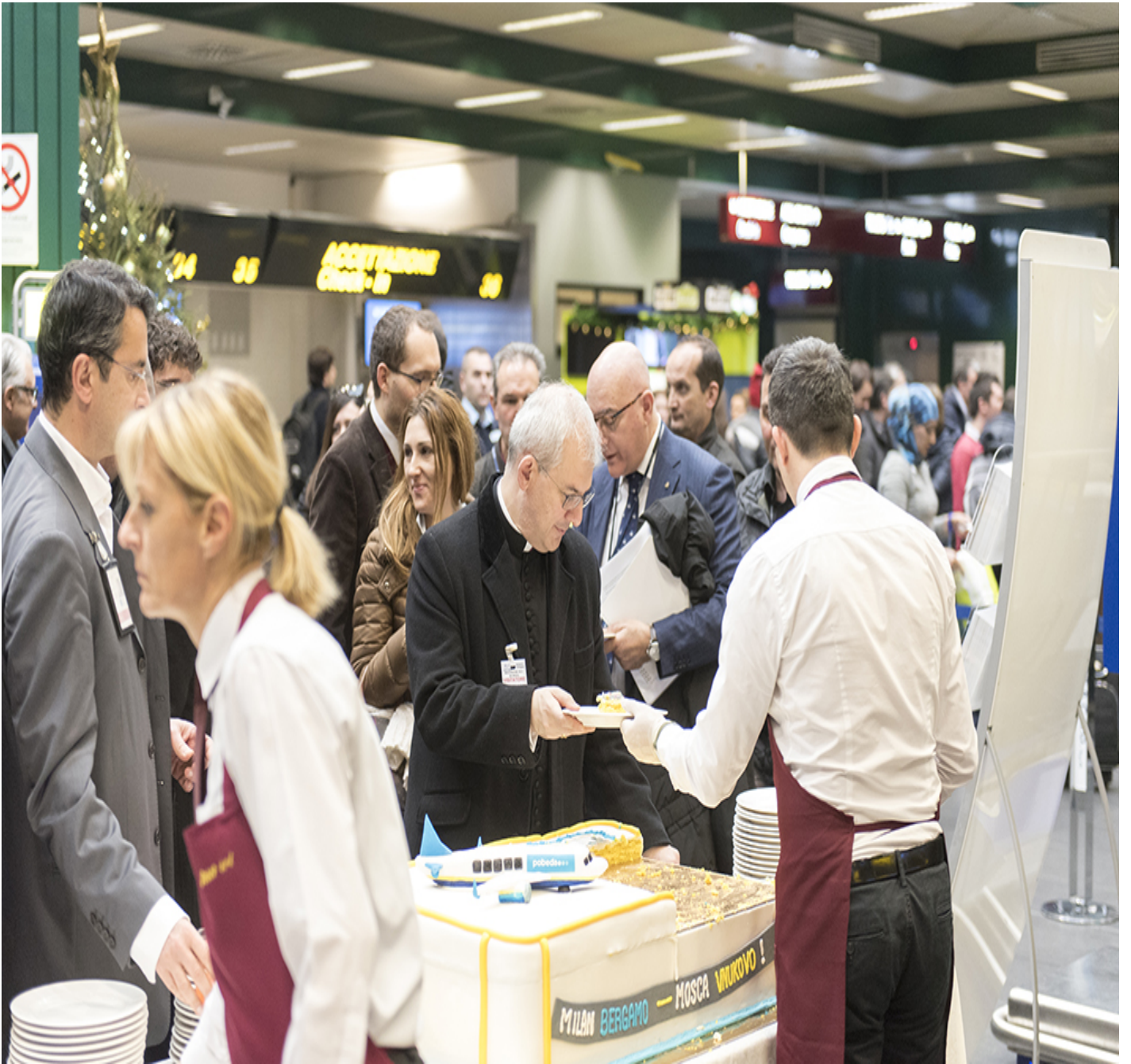
The inaugural flight was celebrated as it arrived at Milan Bergamo by government, airport and airline dignitaries.
