



AIRCLUB WELCOMES JETFLITE AS A NEW MEMBER

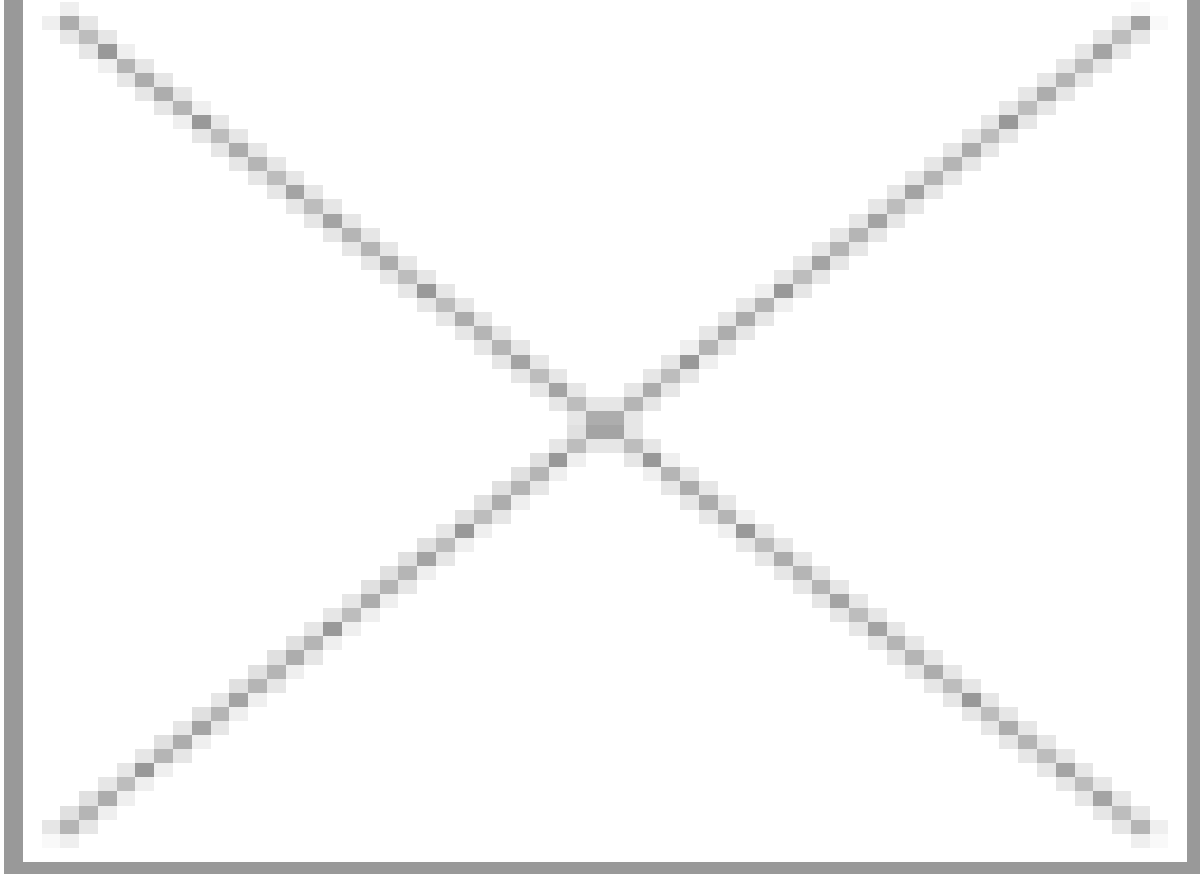
