**As the BizAv community gathers in Las Vegas for NBAA-BACE 2025, Avfuel Corporation reinforces its leadership in sustainability through certifications, expanded fuel supply, and thought leadership at the show’s Business Aviation Sustainability Summit. ### *SAF Supply Leadership and On-Site Engagement*

Avfuel now provides consistent SAF supply to 58 locations across the U.S., U.K., and E.U.—providing more SAF to business aviation operations than any other fuel supplier. In 2025, the company expanded its SAF supply chain (all of which is ISCC certified) to include five states: Florida, New Jersey, Texas, Colorado and California, demonstrating its ongoing investment in accessibility and reliability for operators.
