Bombardier has marked the upcoming delivery of two new entry-long range **Global 5000** aircraft to be operated by longstanding partner and leading business aviation services organisation ExecuJet Middle East of Dubai.

ExecuJet Middle East will manage the aircraft on behalf of two customers in the region.
