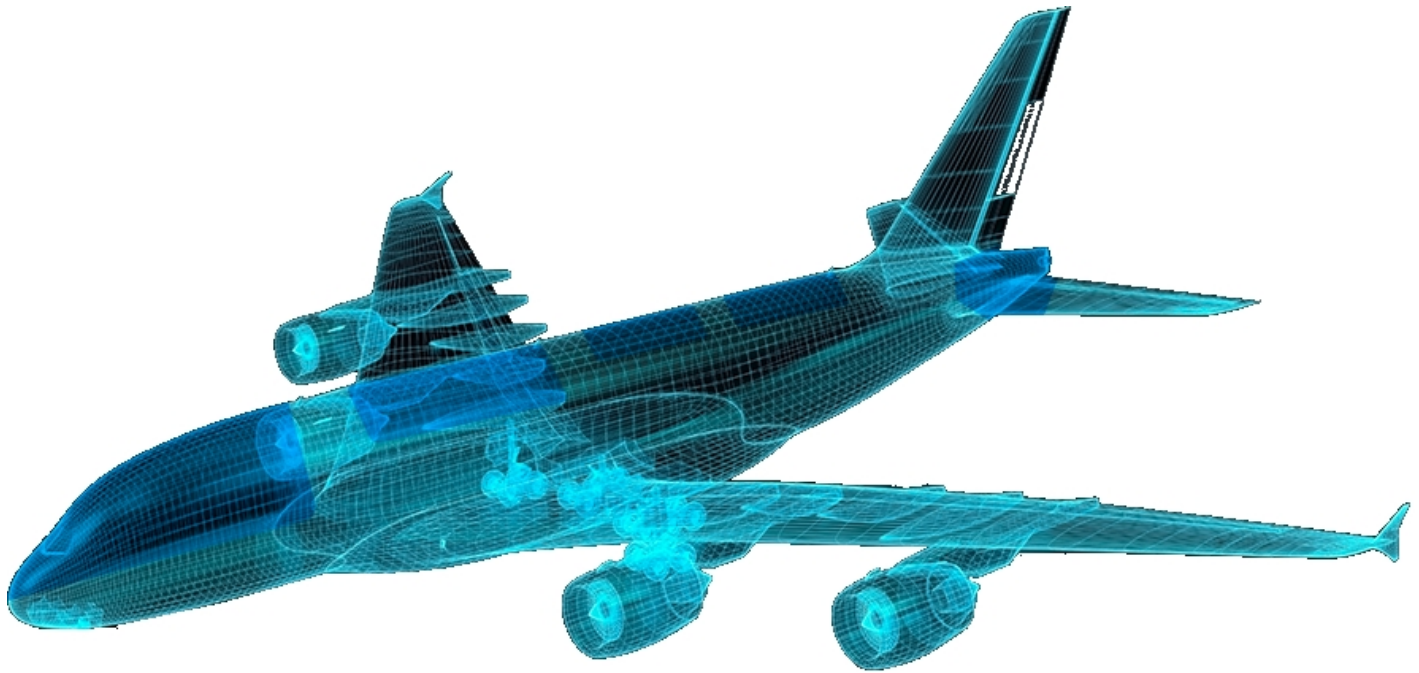




EAD AEROSPACE ACHIEVES JETWAVE STC ON A319
