Jet Luxe's expanded fleet includes aircraft selected for their reliability, cabin comfort, and performance suited to regional and continental missions. **Cessna Citation III** is positioned to serve regional and mid-continental routes efficiently, with an eight-seat cabin and range tailored for frequent corporate and leisure itineraries. Based between Toluca and Fort Lauderdale, it supports cross-border missions with consistent availability.

Hawker 800XP brings a spacious, stand-up cabin to the midsize category and is designed for longer itineraries across Mexico, the United States, and the Caribbean. Its recent interior

refurbishment and dual basing in Cancun and Toluca allow it to serve two of the region's busiest business aviation corridors. Also operating from Toluca and Fort Lauderdale, the **Hawker 750** offers midsize capability with significant external baggage capacity, supporting travelers moving with equipment or multi-day luggage. Its cabin layout ensures comfort on both short and medium-length routes.

Learjet 45XR completes the latest additions, providing the speed and efficiency that have made the model a mainstay in light-to-midsize operations. With bases in San José del Cabo and San Diego, it supports high-demand West Coast, Baja California, and extended regional routes.
