This global coverage delivers connectivity almost anywhere in the world, offering speeds sufficient to support in-flight video conferencing, streaming, and online gaming. As the demand for reliable in-flight internet continues to grow, MEC is at the forefront of introducing this technology to users in Southeast Asia.

With download speeds per terminal ranging from 40-220 Mbps and upload speeds of 8-25 Mbps, Starlink surpasses traditional in-flight Wi-Fi services, offering unparalleled performance.
