Viasat JetXP business aviation in-flight broadband service is now delivering five times more capacity across the Eastern United States, with a phased nationwide expansion in the coming months. All Viasat’s business aviation customers using the Honeywell JetWave or Gogo Plane Simple Ka-band terminals are benefitting from the capacity boost for an even greater connectivity experience, supporting data-hungry applications - such as high-definition video conferencing, content streaming and generative AI – on multiple devices at the same time.

For JetWave customers, the performance can be further optimized by adopting the terminal's latest software version, further details of which can be obtained from their service provider. This step-change in performance has already received a hugely positive response from customers travelling on busy flight routes over major eastern US hubs.
