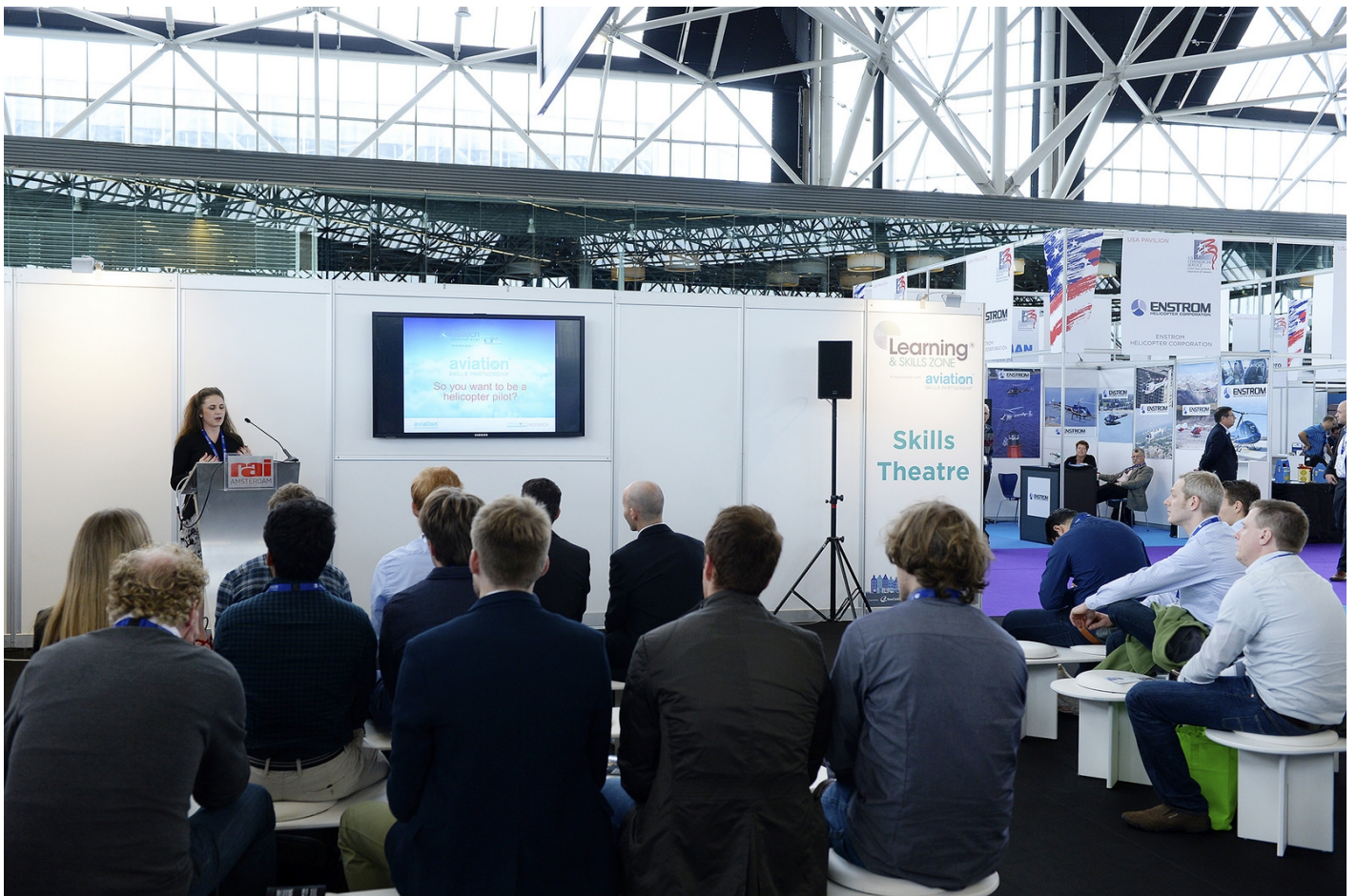


HELITECH INTERNATIONAL PUTS THE SPOTLIGHT ON THE NEXT GENERATION OF AVIATION PROFESSIONALS
