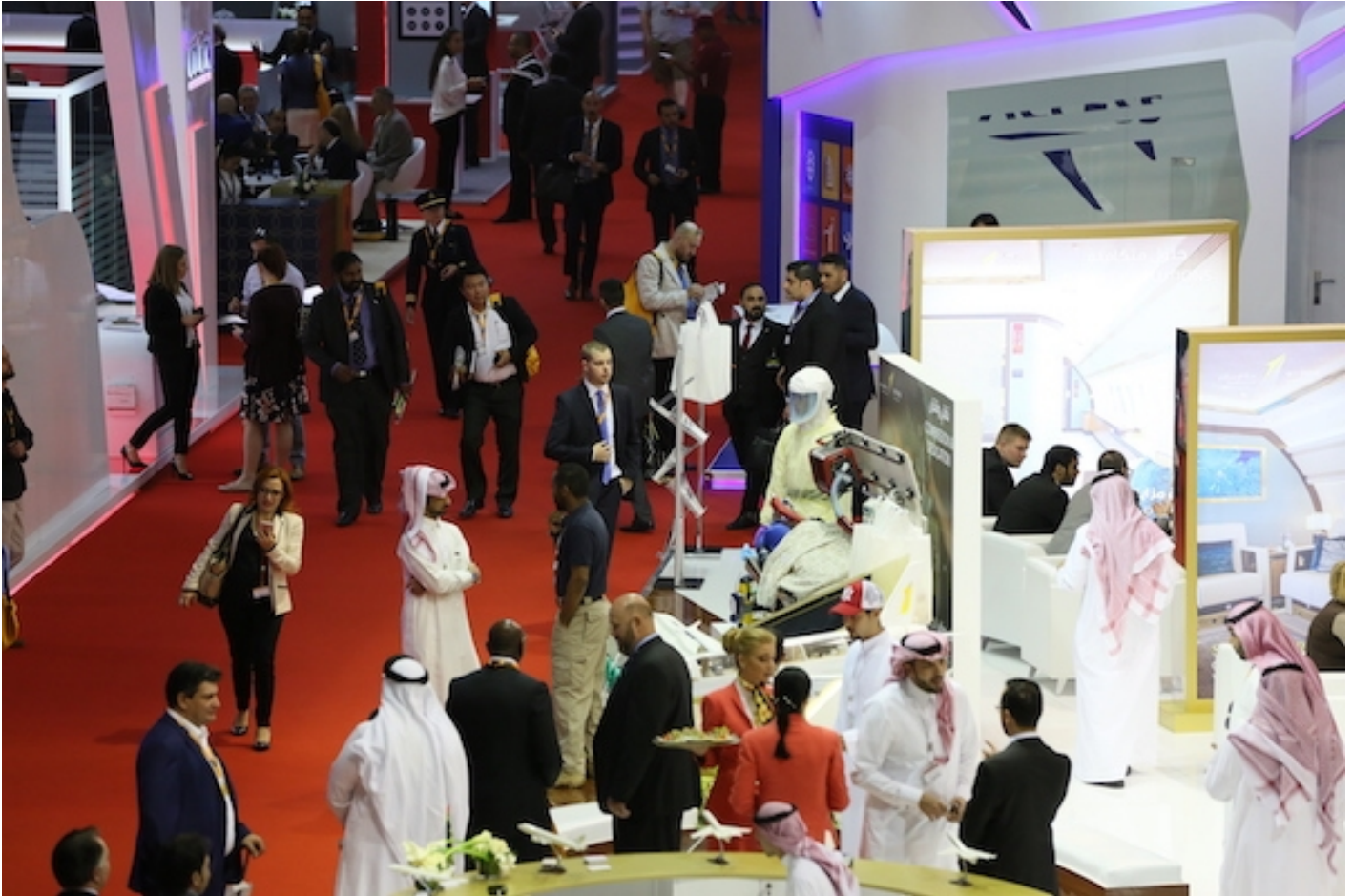




MEBAA - INNOVATIONS IN BUSINESS AVIATION ON SHOW
