



RIGA AVIATION FORUM 2026: EUROPE'S LEADING AVIATION DECISION MAKERS TO CONVENE IN RIGA

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Riga Aviation Forum (RAF), the largest Baltics' flagship high-level aviation business conference, will take place on 10 September 2026 in Riga, Latvia as a gathering point for Europe's aviation leaders, policymakers, industry innovators, and academic experts. Since its establishment in 2016, RAF has evolved into one of the region's most influential platforms for strategic dialogue, policy development, and cross-sector collaboration within the aviation industry.

A strategic platform for Baltic and Northern European aviation

RAF brings together stakeholders from across the aviation ecosystem – airlines, airports, manufacturers, regulators, technology companies, and research institutions – to examine the opportunities and challenges shaping the future of aviation in the Baltic region. The 2026 edition of RAF will place particular emphasis on the transition toward sustainable and climate-neutral aviation. As the industry faces increasing regulatory pressure, evolving passenger expectations, and rapid technological change, RAF will highlight the solutions that can support the Baltic region's leadership in next-generation aviation.

Key discussion areas will include:

- **Baltic Aviation Strategy** – long-term competitiveness, infrastructure development, and regional connectivity
- **Sustainable Aviation** – SAF adoption, fleet modernization, and climate-neutral pathways
- **Innovation & Efficiency** – digitalization, automation, AI-driven operations, and next-gen air traffic management
- **Industry Collaboration** – strengthening partnerships across Europe and the Baltics
