



TAYLOR ENGLISH ADVISES ON \$8 BILLION DEAL FOR RUSSIAN AIRLINES

Taylor English Duma LLP served as outside legal counsel to Russia’s Volga-Dnepr Group on its agreement to acquire 20 Boeing 747-8F aircraft worth \$8 billion. Based in Moscow, Volga-Dnepr Group is a consortium that owns, operates, and manages several cargo airlines.

The deal – announced July 12, 2016 at the Farnborough Air Show – is a landmark transaction. It represents the largest cargo/freighter aircraft order in Boeing’s 100-year history, and will make Volga-Dnepr Group the largest Boeing 747-8F operator in the world.
