



4 ADDITIONAL SONACA 200S FOR AIR ACADEMY NEW CAG

For Air Academy New CAG, the acquisition of 8 Sonaca 200s will complete the renewal of its school aircraft fleet that began in 2015: "Having a new and modern fleet is indispensable and it also shows our expertise and professionalism. The older planes generate maintenance and repair costs (structure and engine parts) and plane immobilization on the ground. We have also noticed that students have less respect for the older planes, they are less careful with these machines which therefore deteriorate even more quickly. "

"This new platform allows us to instantly find all the necessary parts and know the price.
