It also comes with the latest generation image generator, GFC 700 autopilot, and a force feedback system that ensures increased realism. It can also be equipped with either analog or glass backup instruments.

The AL42 model is designed for CPL IR/ME and PPL training in compliance with current regulatory standards of EASA FNPT II (level).
