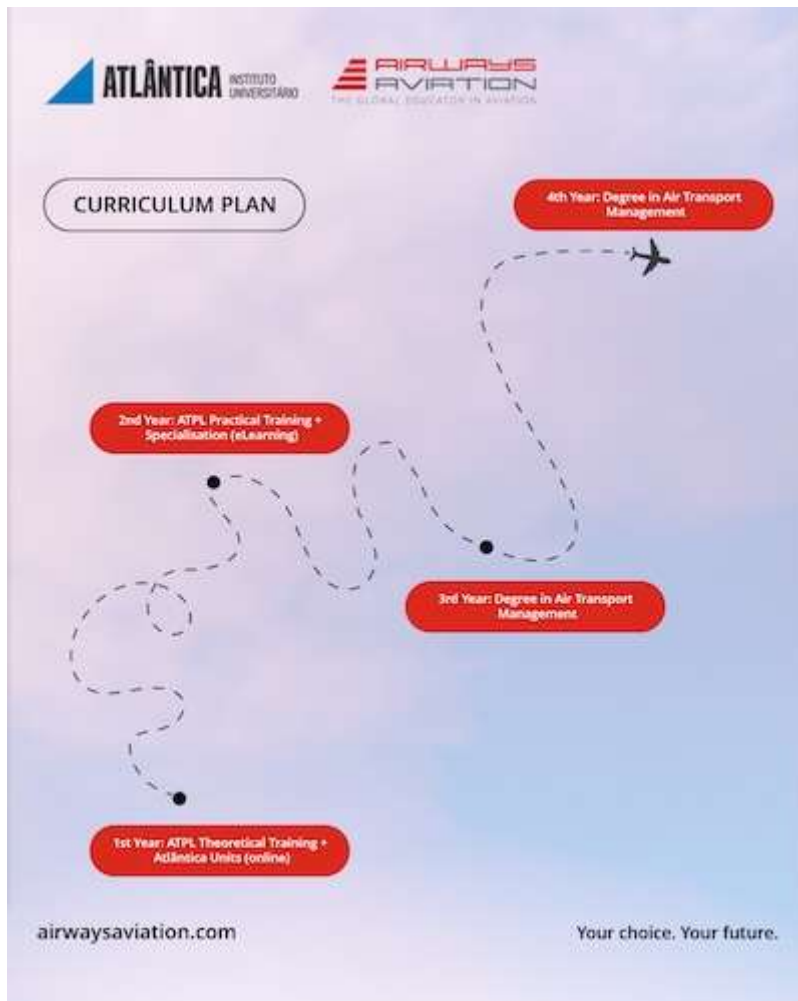


An agreement between the two institutions establishes an integrated training route that offers both a Bachelor's Degree and an ATPL.
