



ATR 72-600 FLIGHT SIMULATOR IN PARIS RECEIVES EASA CERTIFICATION

ATR, the world's leading turboprop manufacturer, has received certification from the European Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) for its new ATR 72-600 Full Flight Simulator (FFS) based at ATR's Paris Training Center. The brand new FFS was manufactured by TRU Simulation + Training and is conveniently located close to Charles de Gaulle airport, which provides connections to any worldwide destination. With ATR operators expected to need around 1,000 new pilots per year, the new simulator will increase ATR's capacity to offer its customers increased pilot training solutions for the market leading aircraft.

Commenting on the announcement, Tom Anderson, Senior Vice-President Programs and Customer Services of ATR, said: "This certification represents another step on our journey to constantly develop our offer to our operators.
