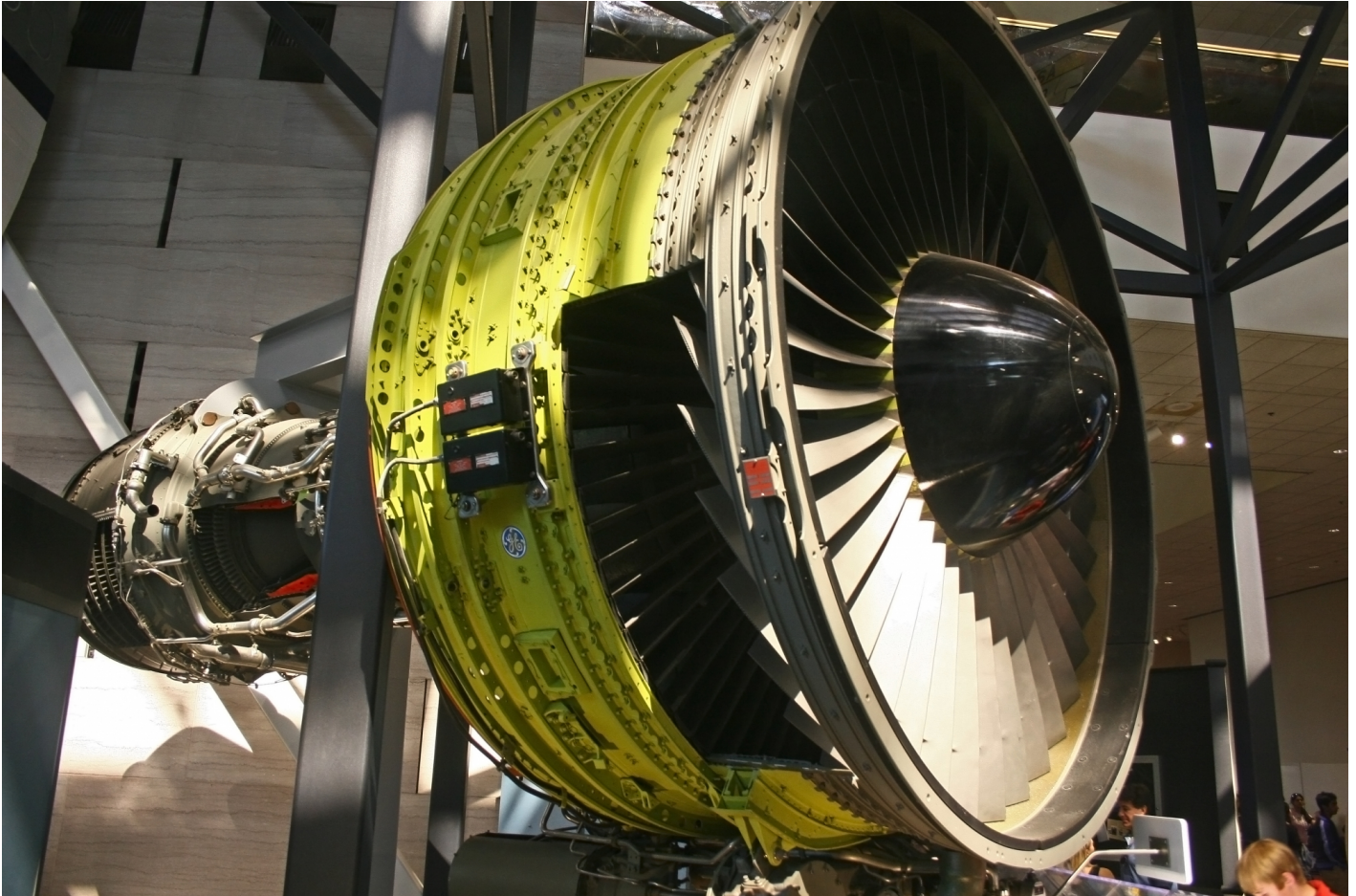




BOC AVIATION SELECTS CF6 ENGINES FOR NEW A330-300 AIRCRAFT
