The new CAE Loganair Graduate Pilot Program provides a direct career path to qualified

graduates covering individual type rating training for ATR42/72, Embraer ERJ 135 and ERJ145 and SAAB 340. The airline will sponsor the type rating training and those who successfully pass will be employed by Loganair on the relevant aircraft. CAE will select, screen, assess and train graduates for Loganair. The program to train over 80 new pilots was recently launched, and the first graduates are already in training. About CAE and Loganair

CAE and Loganair share a long-standing relationship of more than 15 years, with the provision of pilot training on SAAB 340, SAAB 2000, Dornier 328TP FFSs and most recently on the Embraer ERJ145 full-flight simulator. Under the terms of the new pilot training agreement, Loganair's pilots will train at various CAE European training centres including CAE Amsterdam, CAE Copenhagen, CAE London Burgess Hill, CAE Madrid and CAE Stockholm.

Loganair is a major regional airline, headquartered in Glasgow but with crew bases in Aberdeen, Inverness, Dundee, Edinburgh, Newcastle, Londonderry, Chester, Norwich and the Isle of Man. It serves over 60 destinations across the Scottish Highlands and Islands, the UK and Europe - including Dublin, Derry, Donegal, Esbjerg, Dusseldorf, Brussels, Bergen and Stavanger.

The airline currently operates over 1,000 flights every week with a fleet of 44 aircraft ranging from eight to 50 passenger seats – and additionally it operates Saab 340 and ATR 72 freighter aircraft. It carries around 1.4 million passengers per year on its scheduled service network.

Loganair is a codeshare partner of British Airways and has interline agreements with Qatar, Emirates, Turkish Airlines, Air France and KLM. It is a wholly owned subsidiary of Airline Investments Ltd, a UK company. It has over 800 employees of which nearly 300 are pilots.

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
