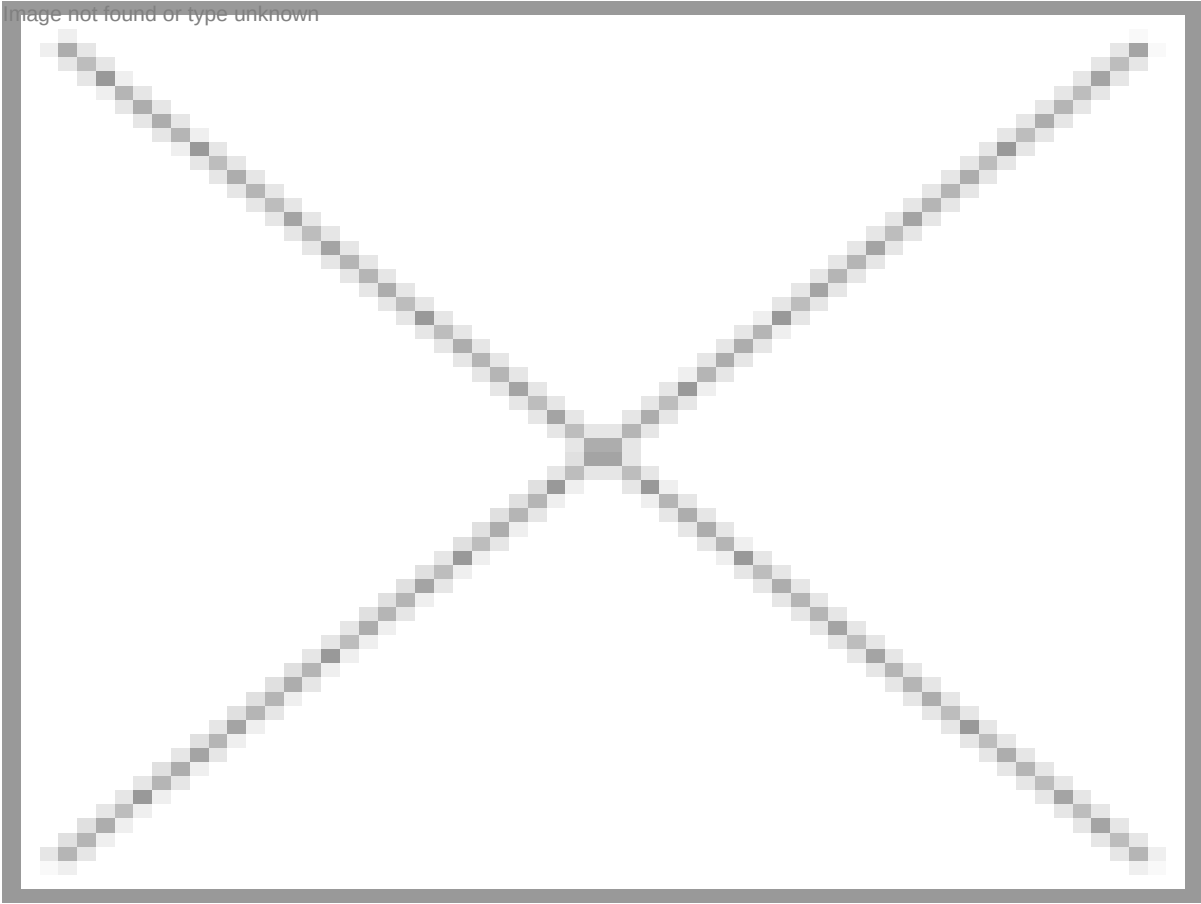
EgyptAir Training Center has passed the European Agency for Safety and Aviation (EASA) inspection.
