



FIRST ALSIM AIRLINER IN CANADA FOR THE CENTRE QUÉBÉCOIS DE FORMATION AÉRONAUTIQUE

ALSIM announced the sale of the first AIRLINER in Canada to the Centre Québécois de Formation Aéronautique (CQFA) for its Montréal campus. AIRLINER is a hybrid simulator (Fly-by-wire and conventional control) manufactured by ALSIM to address large flight training programs for advanced training such as Multi Crew Cooperation, Crew Resource Management, Jet Aircraft Handling and Procedures. The versatile simulator is close to a variety of different single aisle aircraft, such as the B737MAX, A320, A220, E190-E2 or the SSJ100.
