Approximately 75-80 students are trained annually, with the number of students continuously on the increase. The school was the first one to propose private pilot training in the country. Today Fly Coop provides modular CPL/ME + IR (with ATPL theory credit) courses, and is just about to introduce ATP Integrated courses. The school also recently obtained its training approval for MCC, MCCI, STI courses.
