Fly-in-Spain benefited from the Alsim *buyback* offer, which was created by the manufacturer to allow customers to update their fleet with last generation simulators.

The AL250 contains the best, state-of-the-art technology and is EASA-FNPT II (Flight Navigation Procedures Trainer) certified. It addresses initial phase training needs (PPL, CPL, IR/ME) and is SEP/MEP re-configurable. In addition, it offers both classic and glass cockpit instrumentation for each flight model at the simple flick of a switch.

Mr Hans Nerlinger, the senior General Manager of Fly-in-Spain - Flight Training Centre Jerez, explains the reasons why they chose Alsim's AL250, "We chose the AL250 because it's LPV/PBN approved (Performance Based Navigation) which is, according to the new EASA regulation for Instrument Training (IR), a mandatory requirement." He adds: "The second important factor for us is that the aircraft models provided with the AL250, can be easily changed, with no required hardware changes, as this switch is only software based."

Which means the simulator's instructor can propose analogue or glass-cockpit panels, depending on the student's specific training needs."
