



ONFLIGHT RECEIVES AUTHORIZED SERVICE CENTER APPROVAL FOR EMBRAER EXECUTIVE JETS AIRCRAFT

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OnFlight of Cincinnati, Ohio, announced milestone approval and authorization as an Embraer Authorized Service Center by Embraer Executive Jets. In this capacity, OnFlight further expands Embraer's strategic network of MRO services, becoming an Embraer Authorized Service Center focused on Embraer aircraft.
