

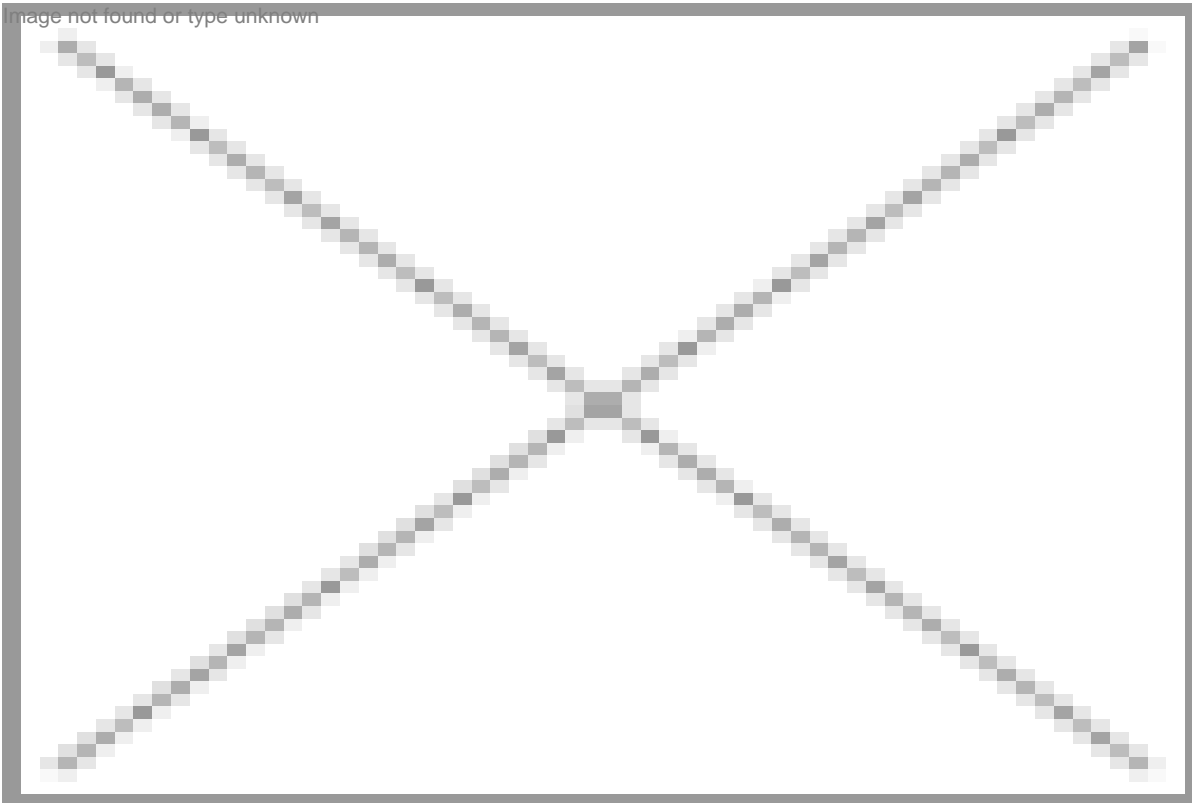
PATRIA FLIGHT SCHOOL RECEIVES NEW DIAMOND TRAINING AIRCRAFT

In January 2017 Patria has purchased five training aircraft and two flight training devices from the Austrian manufacturer Diamond Aircraft Industries GmbH. The purchase consists of four DA40 NG, one DA42-VI and two DA42-VI Flight Navigation and Procedures Trainers (FNPT II). Patria receives the four new Diamond single DA40 NG trainers in June. The DA42-VI will be delivered by the end of August 2017.

The single engine DA40 aircraft will be used for basic and instrument training, while the twin-engine DA42-VI will be used for multi-engine training. The fleet of modern Diamond training aircraft and Flight Training Devices will be used in Patria's new training center in Tampere-Pirkkala, where Patria's civil pilot training operations relocated from Helsinki-Malmi in May 2017.

Modern training fleet

Patria already operates two DA42 NG aircraft. With the new purchase, Patria’s Diamond fleet will include seven training aircraft and two Diamond Flight Training Devices.

Patria will continue to operate nine Tecnam P2002JF aircraft together with the new trainers to answer to strong demand in pilot training markets in Finland and internationally. Last year, Patria also purchased an Airbus A320 FNPT/FTD1 MCC for the MPL training program.
