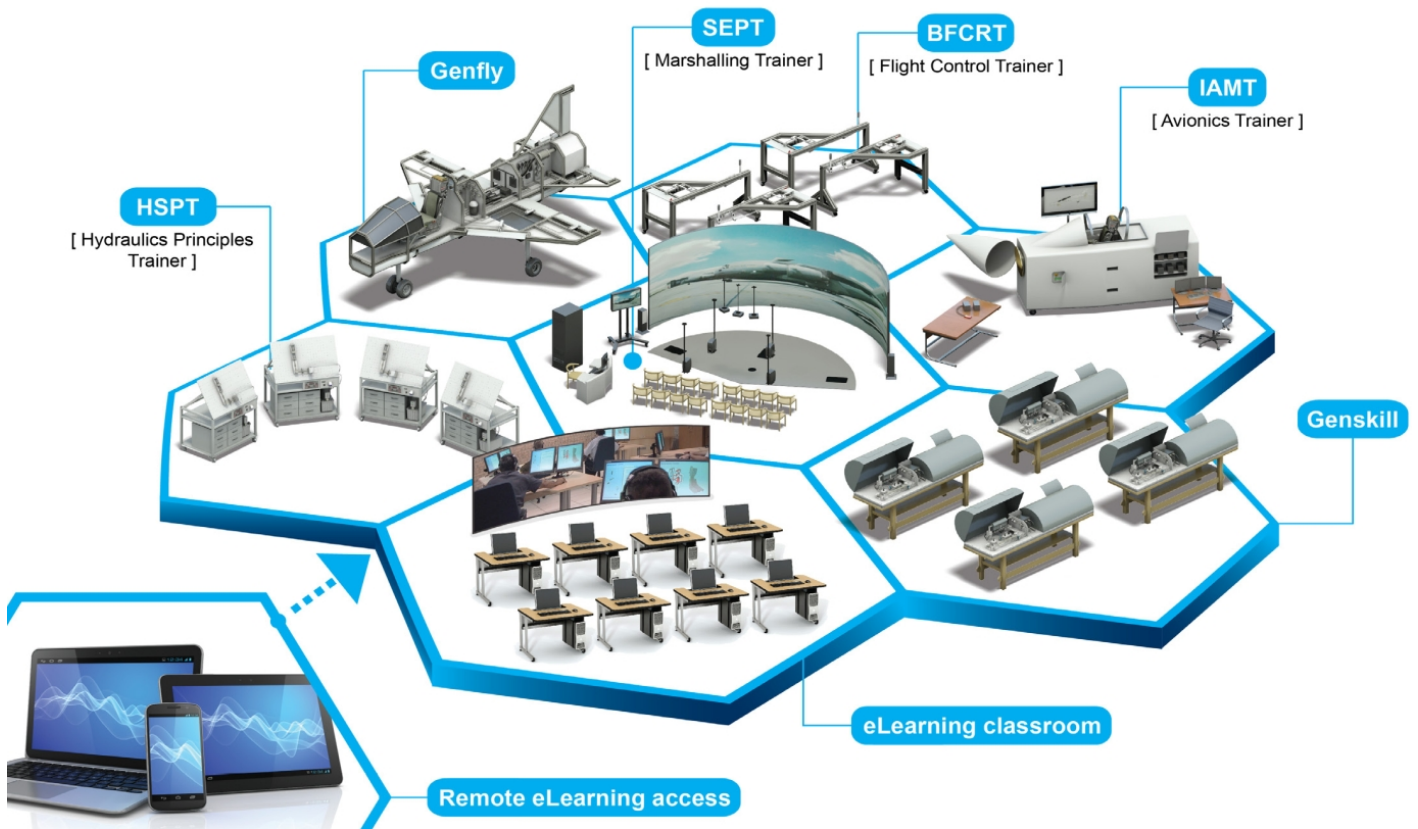
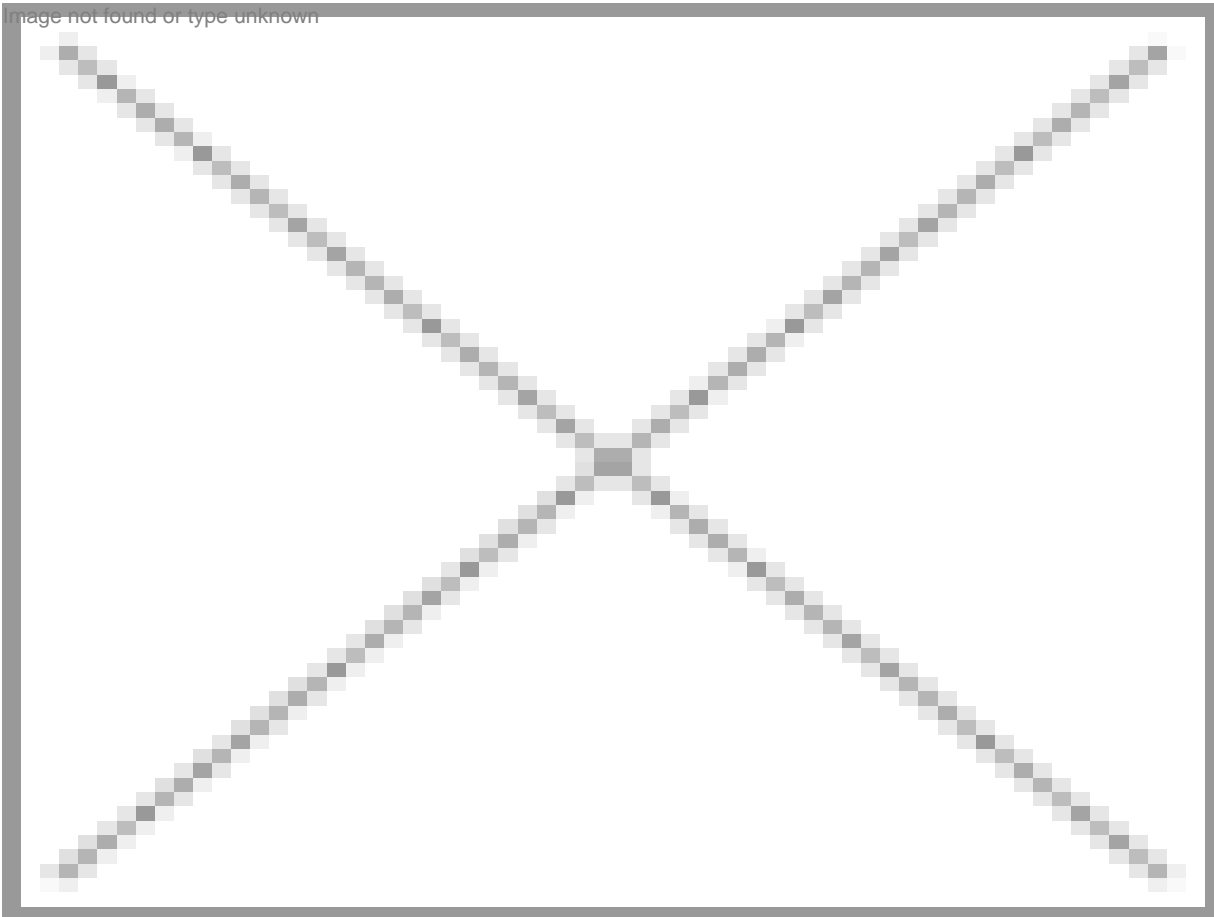


PENNANT AND OMEGA SECURE MIDDLE EAST TRAINING CONTRACTS

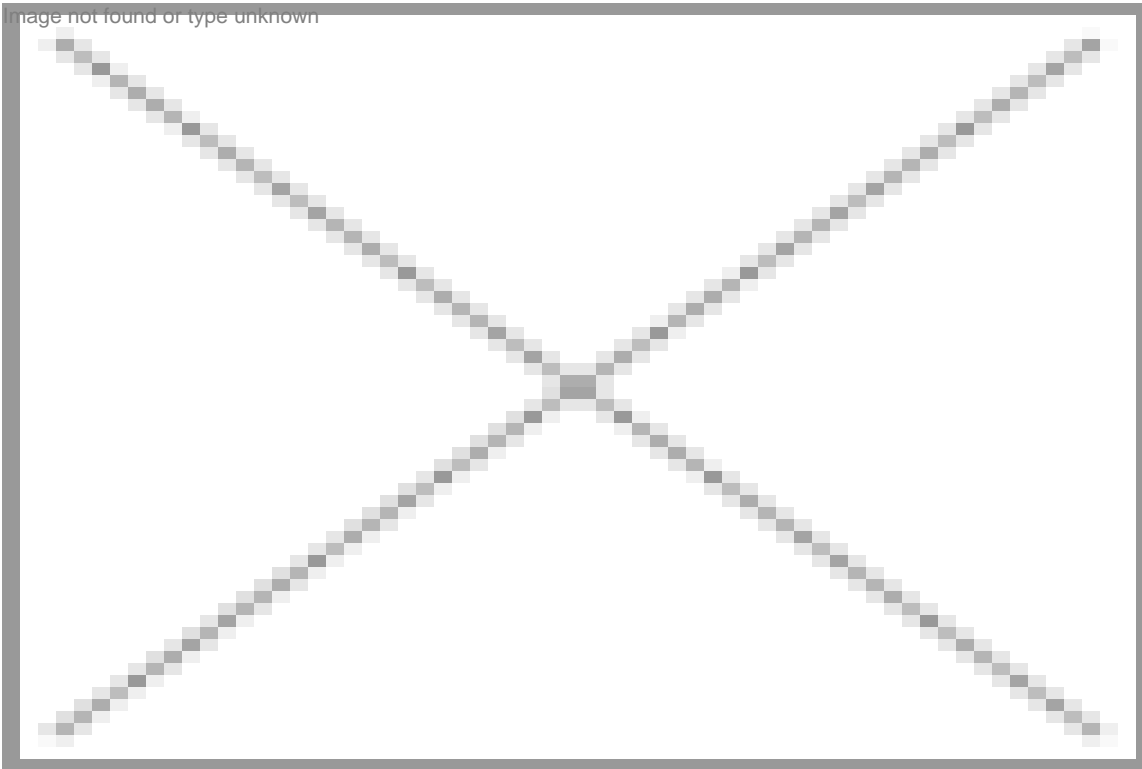


Pennant Training Systems Limited has won two major contracts for Middle Eastern customers worth in excess of £13m.
