Keynote speaker and Master of Ceremonies, Dr Shini Somara, Broadcast journalist in science, technology, innovation and an advocate of STEM education, chaperoned questions from a lively audience of local school children aged between 11-14 and was joined by other guest speakers including Captain Catherine Burton, Commercial Pilot and Diversity Champion and who was the most senior female Captain for British Airways when she retired, Jane Middleton, Chairman of Airlines UK and a Trustee and Honorary Treasurer of the Royal Aeronautical Society and Tess Naran, First Officer from Titan Airways, who as an aspiring astronaut was selected from over 3,500 applicants to reach the top six finalists as part of BBC2's programme *Astronauts: do you have what it takes?*

The 'See Her, Be Her' event, as part of the Farnborough International Airshow 2018, coincides with the centenary year of the RAF and women's suffrage and formed part of the launch platform for a new Women's Charter to support women's progression within aviation.

"We believe wholeheartedly in celebrating female pioneers and role models in the industry" added Alison Chambers, Vice President, WAI UK. "Women continue to be in the minority when it comes to careers in aviation and educating young girls about the opportunities available to them and what they can achieve within the sector is something we will never tire of."
