- New EASy IV flight deck
- New FalconSphere applications
- Dassault's Innovative Cabin System (ICS), designed to combine and simplify control of environmental control and entertainment systems.

As usual, the seminars will offer interactive model-specific and general technical sessions covering topics ranging from troubleshooting to reliability improvements and STC updates. Dedicated pilot sessions, led by the Falcon Pilot Support Team will keep flight crews abreast of the latest developments in flight operations.
