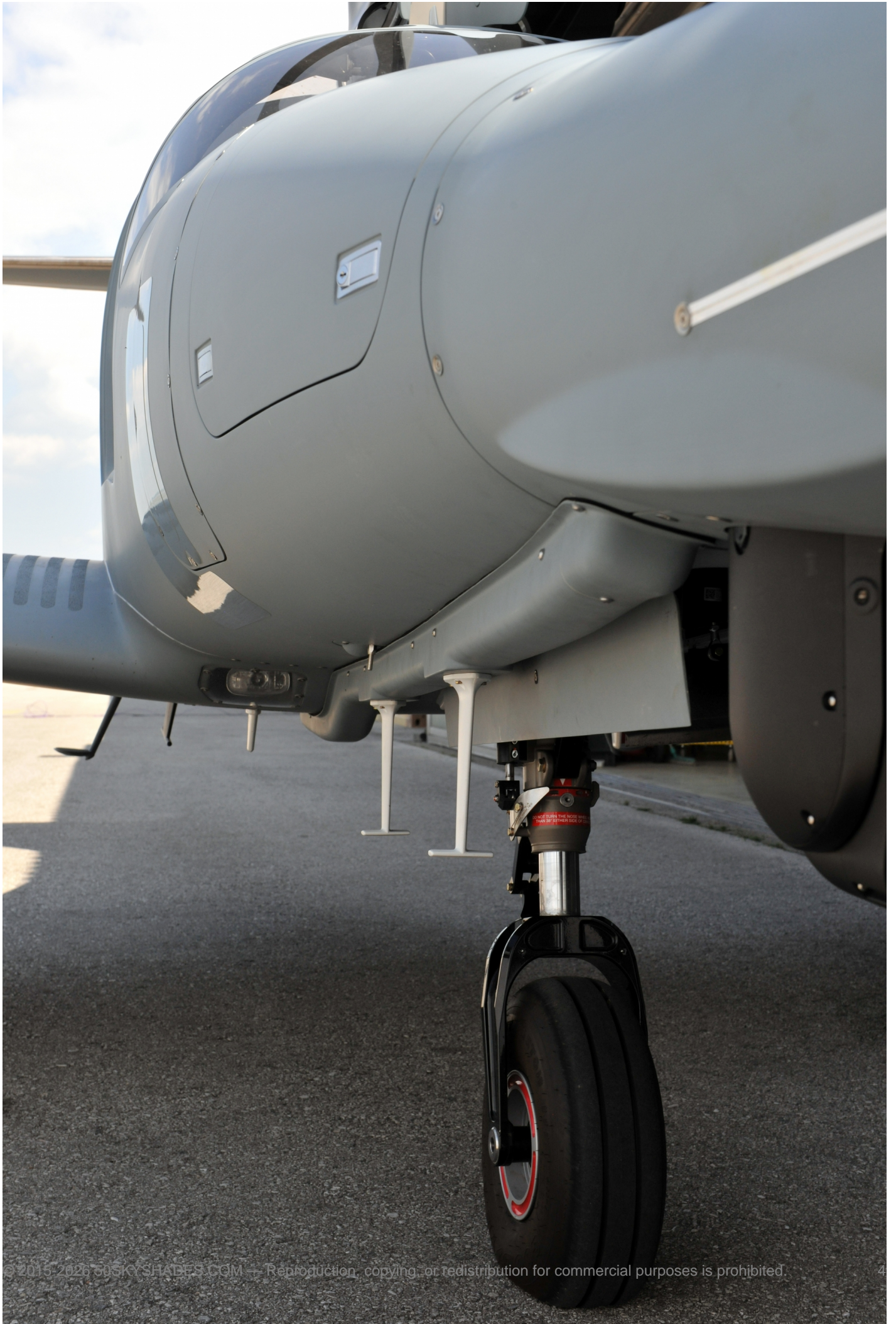




DIAMOND AIRCRAFT TOGETHER WITH PIDSO DEVELOPED AN ALL-NEW ANTENNA SOLUTION
