Piaggio Aerospace is displaying one of its Avanti EVO aircraft in the static area of EBACE.

Clemens Toussaint, Chairman of Aeropolis S.p.A., declared: “My ambitious idea is to develop the extraordinary potential of the runway in Albenga as a modern base for jet owners and operators in the region. Our guests should enjoy the freedom and the liberty of private aviation. Riviera Airport could be also a strategic option for the Principality of Monaco, which has no runway on its own.
