



TRIUMPH GROUP ANNOUNCES ACQUISITION OF FAIRCHILD CONTROLS CORPORATION

Triumph Group, Inc. announced the acquisition of Fairchild Controls Corporation, a leading provider of proprietary thermal management systems, auxiliary power generation systems and related aftermarket spares and repairs, from [Airbus](#) Defense and Space, Inc. The acquired business, which is based in Frederick, Maryland, will operate as Triumph Thermal Systems - Maryland and be included in the Aerospace Systems Group. The business is expected to add approximately \$45.0 million in annual revenue and to be immediately accretive to earnings.

Employing approximately 150 employees, the company's key product offerings include electrically-driven vapor cycle systems and auxiliary power generation technology which delivers supplementary hydraulic power for commercial aircraft and [military](#) platforms. The company also provides proprietary aftermarket spares repair and overhaul services to a large, global installed base of over 3,500 systems.

Richard C. III, Triumph's President and Chief Executive Officer, said, "We are pleased to have acquired Fairchild Controls, which will augment our current capabilities and allow us to offer both air and liquid cooling systems for thermal management. Through this acquisition, we obtained custom, high reliability control solutions with a recurring proprietary aftermarket and have positioned ourselves as a world-class provider of thermal management and auxiliary power generation systems. We are pleased that the management team, led by Peter Borgel, will remain with Triumph to continue to deliver exceptional value to their customers."
