

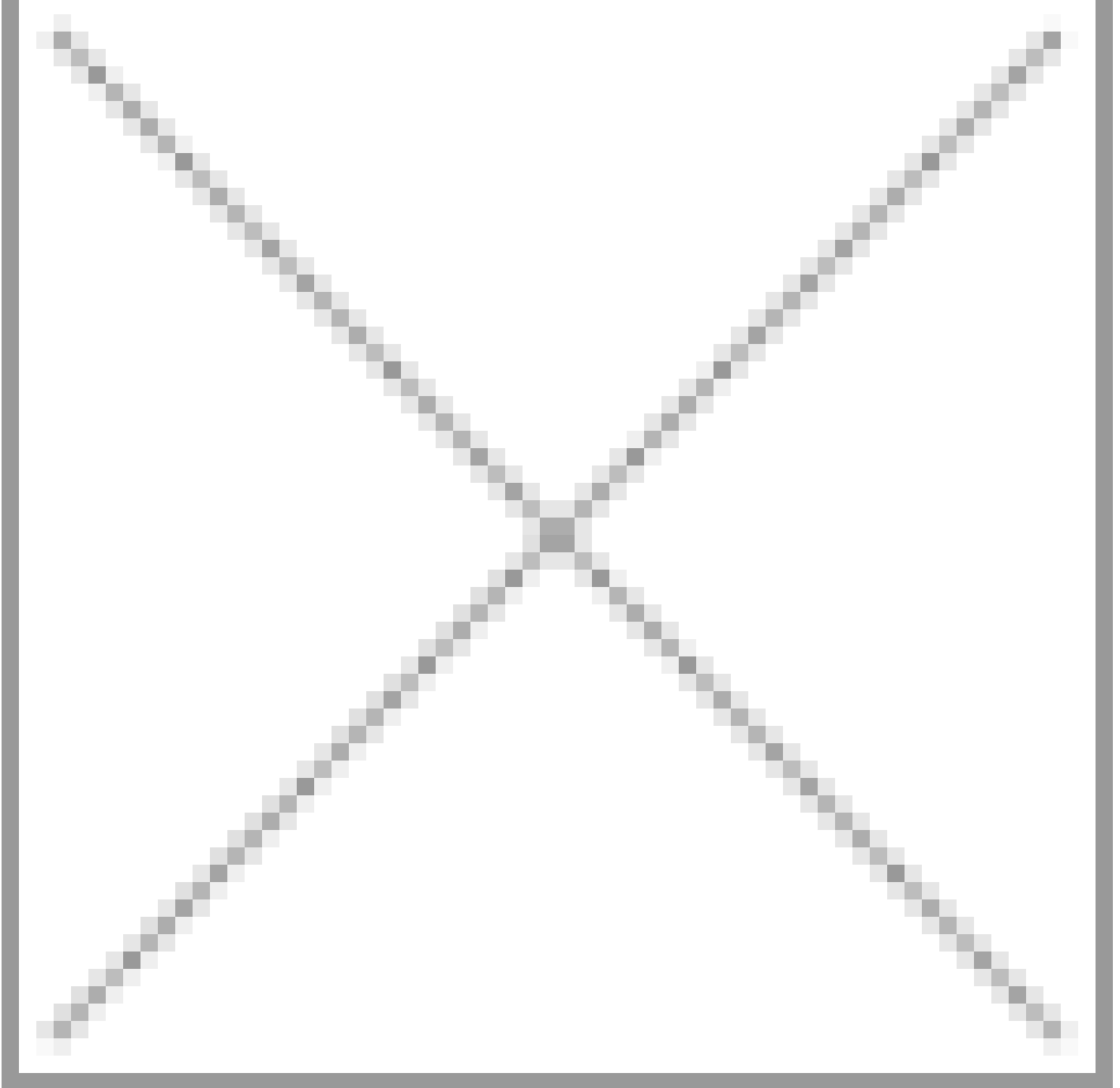


AIR PARTNER APPOINTS SETH ROTMAN AS DIRECTOR OF BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT IN THE US
