



ETIHAD AIRWAYS APPOINTS LINDSAY WHITE VICE PRESIDENT AUSTRALIA AND ASIA PACIFIC

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Etihad [Airways](#), the national airline of the United Arab Emirates, has appointed Mr Lindsay White to the new position of Vice President for Australia and Asia Pacific.
