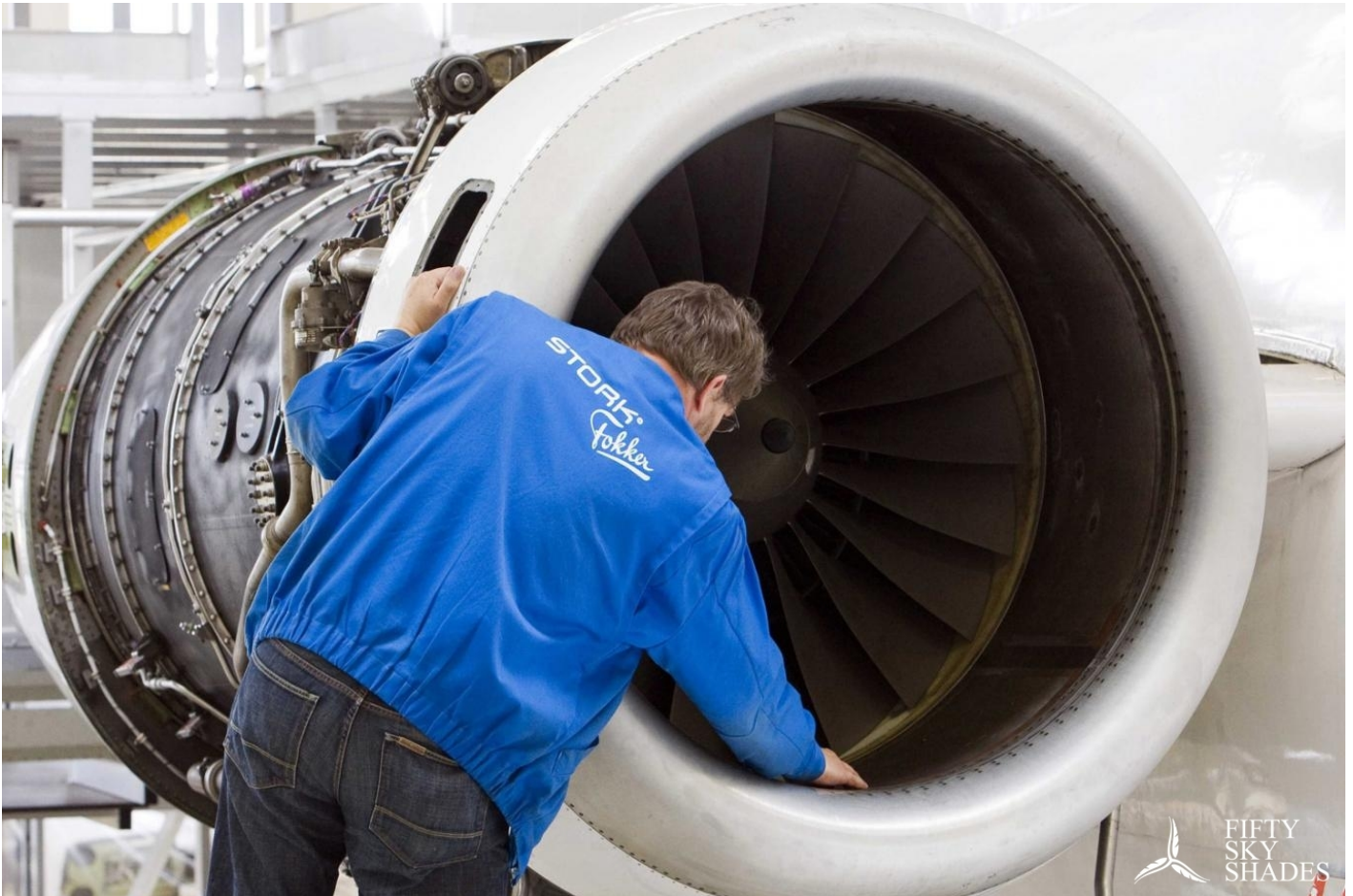




FOKKER NAMES P.HARTMAN AS CHAIRMAN OF SUPERVISORY BOARD

Following the acquisition of **Fokker** by GKN Aerospace, which completed on 28 October, several changes have been announced to the Fokker Supervisory Board.

Peter Hartman has been appointed **Chairman of the Supervisory Board**, effective from 28 October 2015. Hans Peter Ring retains his current position on the Supervisory Board.
