

GULFSTREAM AEROSPACE APPOINT REGIONAL VICE PRESIDENT OF NEW AIRCRAFT SALES FOR AFRICA

Gulfstream Aerospace has promoted Nicolas Robinson to the position of regional vice president of new aircraft Sales for Africa.
