Amongst other achievements, she established the central sales department “Customer Service” of Lufthansa Cargo for the German market in 2006, which she managed until 2010. Most recently she was in charge of logistics within the context of the project LCCneo, aiming to establish modern logistics processes,

technologies and IT in the new air cargo hub (LCCneo) of Lufthansa Cargo.

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
