



AIRBALTIC PASSENGERS UP + 12%

In March 2017, the Latvian airline *airBaltic* carried 224 921 passengers or +12% more than in the same period of 2016 throughout its network spanning Europe, Scandinavia, Russia, CIS and the Middle East. During the first three months of 2017, *airBaltic* has transported a total of 588 768 passengers.

In March the airline operated 3 667 flights, or +14% more than in the same period of 2016, when *airBaltic* operated 3 230 flights. During the first three months of 2017 the airline operated 10 160 flights.

The airline's load factor, which represents the number of passengers as a proportion of the number of available seats, was at a level of 68% in March 2017. During the first three months of 2017, *airBaltic* load factor was at a level of 66%.

The 15-minute flight punctuality indicator for *airBaltic* reached a level of 92,3% in March 2017. This means that more than 92 of every 100 *airBaltic* flights in this year March departed at the planned time or with a delay of no more than 15 minutes.

This summer, *airBaltic* will add 12 new routes to its network to such cities as Madrid, Geneva,

Aberdeen, Tampere, Stavanger, Gothenburg, Kazan, Catania and Liepaja.
